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## What is Outcome Based Assessment

Outcome Based Assessment approach is a type of evaluative method set by the Nursing and Midwifery board of Australia (NMBA) in March 2020 to assess a learner's knowledge, skills and attributes in contributing to the care of Australian nationals.

Outcome Based Assessment (OBA) is a two-step process of assessment for internationally qualified nurses and midwives (IQNMs). The first stage will test the nurse's knowledge through Next Generation NCLEX (NGN) examination. The second stage is an assessment of a nurse's behavioural aspect through the Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE).
